

Ligonier Township Supervisors

Minutes

12 October 2010

The Supervisors of Ligonier Township met in regular session at 7pm, with all three Supervisors present:

Timothy R Komar, Chairman, William C Penrod Jr and Keith A Whipkey.

There being no comments from the audience, a motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to approve the minutes of the 14 September meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Penrod and seconded Komar to approve the Treasurer's report for September. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to approve payment of the current bills. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to accept the Police Incident report for September. Motion carried.

Zoning Office – Cynthia J Turley

1. Turley requested the Supervisors appoint alternates to the Zoning Hearing Board

New business:

1. A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to release the road bond for C&S Lumber on Kissell Springs Road. Motion carried.
2. A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to table accepting the resignation of Matthew Sherer as Patrolman. Motion carried.
3. It was announced that Piper Brothers expect to change the location of their road bond.
4. Komar announced that the Township will be selling a leaf blower on on-line auction in the near future.
5. Supervisors announced receipt from PennDOT of a supplemental agreement for the 2-year bridge inspection of the Township. It will result in a minor increase of funds to the Township. The Chairman was instructed by the Board to sign the appropriate documents.
6. Rose Stepnick announced that construction of the Ligonier Valley Trail is underway and will continue.
7. It was noted that that a house at 141 Stoner Lane is abandoned and may become a hazard. Turley commented that County funds were available for demolition of dilapidated buildings, but it seems in recent years that the money seems to be directed elsewhere.
8. Penrod acknowledged Dave Hunter for donating a huge flag to the Township.

A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to adjourn the meeting at 7:17 pm.
