## From the desk of Ligonier Township Police Chief Michael Matrunics

Since I took over the department, I always like to take this opportunity to provide information to the residents of the Ligonier Township. For this quarterly newsletter I would like to fill you in on what has been going on in the Police Department.

In the year of 2010 the department was very busy. The department is still actively patrolling the streets 24 hours a day, seven days a week. On average officers handle between 300 to 400 calls a month, racking up approximately 5000 miles a month responding to these calls and actively providing patrol. Even though we are on active patrol around the clock we still need help from the community when they see something that needs reported to the police. You may question yourself, "How do I call for a police officer". Well, that answer is "Call 911". Yes, it is okay to call this number even though there may not be an active emergency going on. In cooperation with our Westmoreland County 911 Center, they understand being a rural type community we do not have the resources to provide man power to answer a local non-emergency phone number 24 hours a day. Please call 911 if you need to speak with a police officer. There have been cases when 911 should have been called versus leaving a message. This could mean the safety of an innocent victim.

### **Parking and Snow Removal**

The Ligonier Township Supervisors would like to remind all township residents that during the winter months any on-street parking that interferes with snow removal will be cause for a ticket. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated because it makes our job easier and snow removal can be done in a more timely fashion. Also be reminded that it is difficult for truck drivers to see what is behind them, especially at intersections, and to minimize the risk of being backed into, we recommend you stay back a minimum of 500 feet.

#### **Blood Drive**

The Ligonier Township Supervisors will be holding a blood drive at the Ligonier Township Municipal Building on Monday, January 17 between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. The blood drive is being held through the Central Blood Bank. All blood donated through the Central Blood Bank stays in the Pittsburgh and outlaying areas, including Westmoreland County. ## TAX COLLECTOR

Ligonier Township spring property taxes (County and Township) will be mailed March 1, 2011. Discount amount will be honored through April 30, face amount through June 30 and penalty amount through December 31, 2011. Ligonier Township fall property taxes (School) will be mailed August 1, 2011. Discount amount will be honored through September 30, face amount through November 30 and penalty amount through December 31, 2011. All payments must be accompanied with a tax statement. If a receipt is requested, please include a self addressed, stamped return envelope. Tax statements are no longer mailed to the mortgage companies. Tax statements are mailed to the taxpayer. If applicable, please forward your statement to the mortgage company for prompt payment. Failure to receive a tax statement does not relieve the taxpayer of the responsibility of payment. If you do not receive a tax statement. please contact the tax office. Pavments made December 1 through December 31 must be paid with a certified check, cashiers check or money order. A drop-off slot is available at the tax collectors office to accept payments before or after normal business hours. Please keep your addresses updated with the tax office.
